Documents & Information Necessary to Complete an

Application for Health Insurance

The following information is needed for everyone who is applying for benefits or whom you claim as a tax dependent on your federal income tax return.

PROOF OF IDENTITY

Please bring in a state driver's license or ID, passport, birth certificate and social security card, residency card, school picture ID, etc.

PROOF OF U.S. CITIZENSHIP OR IMMIGRATION STATUS

Please bring in a passport, birth certificate, legal permanent resident card, visa, naturalization paperwork, employment authorization card, etc.

PROOF OF INCOME

Please bring in two recent paystubs if you or a family member are currently working. If you or a family member are receiving social security benefits, please bring in a copy of the award letter. If you or a family member are not working and receiving unemployment benefits, please bring a copy of the award or benefit letter.

Please bring in a complete copy of your most recently filed federal income tax return (form 1040 with all schedules and attachments) if any family member is self-employed, has rental income, or has investment income.

PROOF OF SSN

You will need to know the social security number for each individual in the household.

ACCESS TO EMPLOYER SPONSORED INSURANCE

If your employer or your spouse's employer offers health insurance, ask their Human Resources department these questions:

- Do any of the health plans that the employer offers meet the "minimum value" standard?
- What is the employee contribution to the lowest-cost health plan offered for an individual? For a family?
- How often? (e.g. weekly, every 2 weeks, twice a month, monthly)
